I wish you all well, thank you for being excellent ambassadors of the school, and best of luck whatever your future holds. You will always be part of The Minster School family.

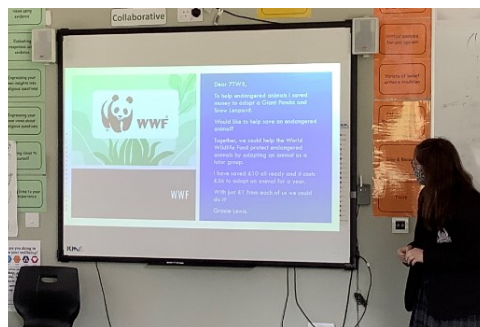

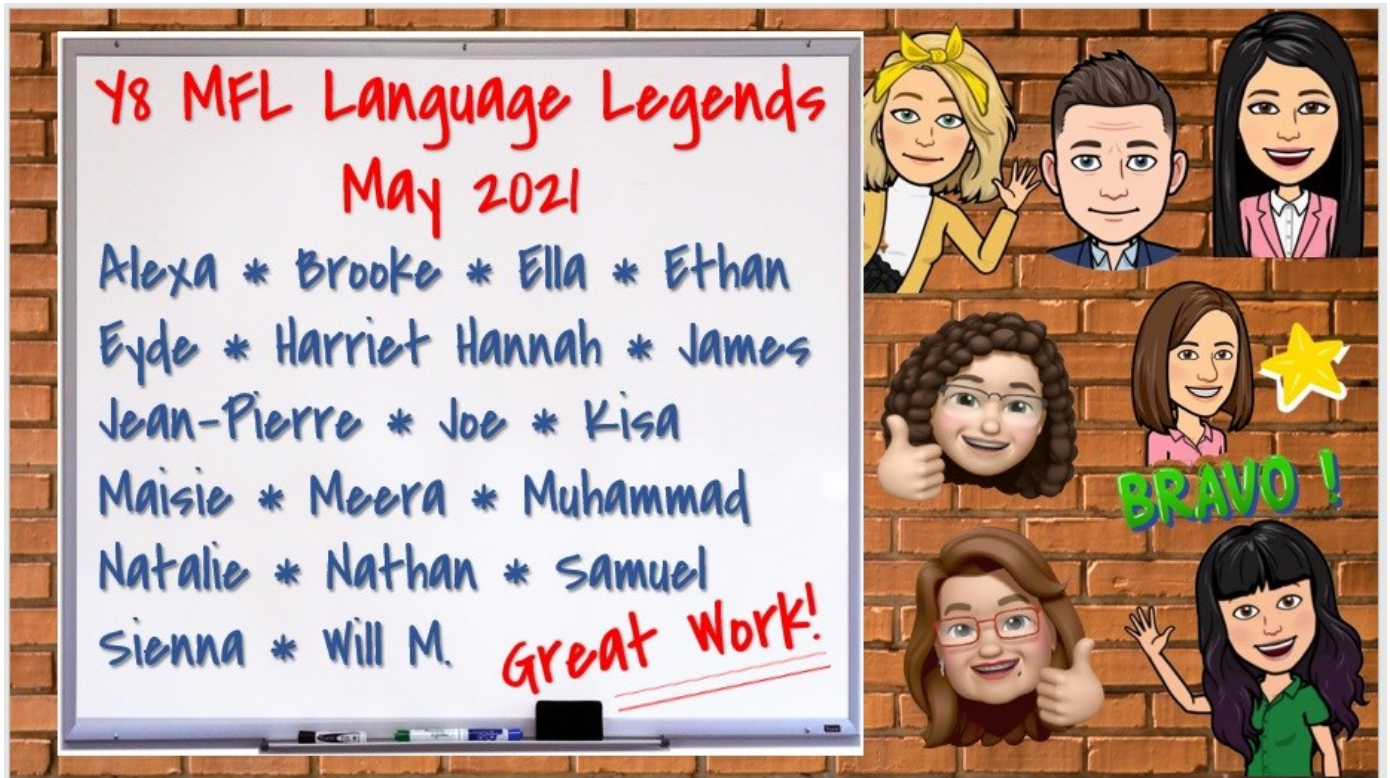

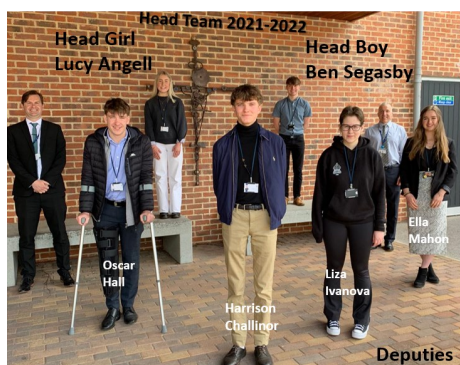
