

## Clubs and activities

<b>Dungeons &amp; Dragons (Roleplaying Games) Club</b>	Students meet to run/play games of Dungeons & Dragons or other fantasy / science-fiction roleplaying games.
<b>Code Club</b>	Code club is for all students who wish to learn about coding and computing. On a Wednesday after school.
<b>Code Club for Girls (Wednesday)</b>	Code club is for female students who wish to learn about coding and computing. On a Wednesday after school.
<b>French club</b>	Learning more about the French culture and language, as well as watching some French films and listening to French music.
<b>History Film Club</b>	Students watch Historical films and then carry out debates/activities based on these.
<b>Junior School Handbells team, the Minster Minis</b>	Handbell tuition on a two-octave set of Whitechapel Bells and hand chimes.
<b>Y12 Debate Group</b>	Y12 'self-led' Debate Group. Students lead on this group and decide the topics and parameters of the debate. This takes place in their break time.
<b>Filmosophy</b>	Discussing themes and questions raised by films. Enjoy film clips, popcorn and discussion.
<b>Basketball Club</b>	KS3 students play a series of basketball games and practice skills
<b>Brilliant Book Award Club</b>	Part of the "Brilliant Book Award" in school. Thursday lunchtimes students who are participating can come to the library to read the books on the shortlist or chat to others about the books to share opinions.
<b>Brass Ensemble</b>	Open to brass players, grade 2+, working towards performances and events - a variety of repertoire
<b>Jazz Band</b>	Musical Ensemble open to Grade 6+ instrumentalists.
<b>Concert Band</b>	Musical ensemble open to grade 2+ wind / brass & percussion players
<b>Music Tech Club</b>	An introduction to music technology through composition projects.
<b>Music Theory</b>	Tailored individual support in Music Theory
<b>KS4/KS5 Composition Support</b>	A session to work on music coursework with teacher support
<b>Sound Sessions</b>	An opportunity for musicians and those wishing to develop some instrumental/vocal band skills to meet rehearse and collaborate. Open to years 7-13.
<b>Creative Writing</b>	Yrs 9-11 to work on creative writing skills in a mutually supportive atmosphere. Sessions are every Thursday 3.00pm- 4.00pm in B27.
<b>Full Choir</b>	Range of repertoire. Open to all students. Rehearsals on Wednesday at 10.50am in The Recital Hall.
<b>Chamber Choir</b>	Audition entry. Classical Choral repertoire with an expectation to read music or learn quickly.

<b>Training orchestra</b>	Open to students in grade 1-4. Rehearsals take place on Tuesdays from 3-4pm. Strings, wind, brass, percussion instruments welcome.
<b>Strings</b>	Grade 5+ Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass. Rehearsals on Thursday 10.50am in A5.
<b>KS3 textile catch up</b>	After school session to continue textile practical or to extend the techniques students are using in lessons.
<b>Year 11 Food Preparation and Nutrition</b>	Tuesday after school in D60 Opportunities to focus on revision and enhance learning of key concepts
<b>GCSE Art Club</b>	An opportunity for GCSE students to carry on coursework development and have additional conversations regarding their work.
<b>A Level Art Club</b>	An opportunity for A level students to carry on coursework development and have additional conversations regarding their work.
<b>KS3 Netball</b>	Opportunities for students to develop and extend their netball skills. Teams selected to represent the school in regional competitions.
<b>Football</b>	Opportunities for students to develop and extend their football skills. Teams selected to represent the school in regional competitions.
<b>Rugby</b>	Opportunities for students to develop and extend their rugby skills. Teams selected to represent the school in regional competitions.
<b>Girls Football</b>	Opportunities for students to develop and extend their football skills. Teams selected to represent the school in regional competitions.
<b>Dodgeball</b>	An introduction to a new and fun sport. Great for social interaction.
<b>A Level PE Support</b>	An opportunity for students to extend their knowledge and understanding - one to one teacher support.
<b>GCSE PE Support</b>	An opportunity for students to extend their knowledge and understanding - one to one teacher support.
<b>Hockey</b>	Development of hockey skills in competitive game situations.
<b>Basketball</b>	Development of more advanced Basketball skills in a competitive environment.
<b>Badminton</b>	Coaching provided by a professional coach. At KS3 level - development of a full range of core skills. At KS4 level - advanced tactical development in line with GCSE specifications.
<b>KS3 Wellbeing</b>	An opportunity to work with a specialist instructor to focus on mindfulness and develop stress management skills.
<b>Trampolining</b>	Development of a range of skills, which can then be put into routines.
<b>KS4/5 Netball</b>	An opportunity for students to develop a range of skills in competitive situations, leading to representation to regional level.
