I am very pleased with how committed the handbell ringers are and how well the rehearsals have gone, especially since we had a few new members join us in September. The handbells team consists of twelve ringers and we have been practising two carols and two pieces from our Pantomime repertoire from last year. Mrs Wallis-Windle has asked us to perform at a concert on 19th December, to entertain some senior citizens from Southwell. We intend to perform the carols and both pieces, Clare de Lune and Frère Jacques, if time allows. The concert will be held in our Main Hall and is not open to Junior School parents, sadly,

Our new members have strengthened the team and allow us a little flexibility if one or two ringers cannot attend a rehearsal. One ringer with a broken hand, even comes to rehearsals and rings one handed each week!

We have embarked on the Handbell Ringers of Great Britain's Crescendo training scheme. This involves showing aptitude in many different aspects and covers notation, ring styles, music theory as well as proficiency in ringing handbells. Most team members have qualified in the level 1 programme (called pp) and will be receiving a badge and a certificate in due course from the Handbell Ringers of Great Britain. There are four stages (pp, mp, mf and ff) with seventy areas of musicality to cover. I am confident that all ringers will be able to gain at least level three by the end of July 2023.

Due to increased demand, we have started a junior training group with Mr Dring and this group is learning to play Belleplates. We had a mini concert this week with both teams giving a performance to each other. I was so impressed with the standard of ringing from both teams. Well done all.
